LOAN GUARANTY INFORMATION LETTER #26-03-14 (**Update 2**) —

TO: ALL LENDERS, HOLDERS, AND SERVICERS

SUBJ: LOAN GUARANTY REQUIREMENTS REGARDING HURRICANE AND SEVERE STORM DAMAGE IN VIRGINIA, MARYLAND, AND DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

1. **PURPOSE:** The purpose of this release is to update the list of independent cities and counties in the state of Virginia for which federal disaster declarations were issued as a result of hurricane Isabel, and to add ten (10) counties in West Virginia for which a similar disaster declaration was made.

2. **AREAS AFFECTED:** In addition to the federal disaster declarations made on September 19 and 20, 2003, for the Virginia independent cities and counties listed in Loan Guaranty Information (LGI) Letter 26-03-14 and Update 1 thereto, a disaster declaration was made on **September 23, 2003**, for the following independent cities and counties in **Virginia**:

The cities of Bedford, Buena Vista, Charlottesville, Fredericksburg, Harrisonburg, Lynchburg, Manassas, Manassas Park, and Winchester; and the counties of Albemarle, Amelia, Amherst, Appomattox, Bedford, Buckingham, Campbell, Charlotte, Clarke, Culpeper, Cumberland, Dinwiddie, Fauquier, Frederick, Greene, Halifax, Hanover, King George, King William, King and Queen, Louisa, Loudoun, Lunenburg, Madison, Nelson, New Kent, Nottoway, Pittsylvania, Powhatan, Prince Edward, Rappahannock, Rockingham, Shenandoah and Warren.

A disaster declaration was also made on **September 23, 2003**, for the following counties in **West Virginia**:

Berkeley, Grant, Hampshire, Hardy, Jefferson, Mineral, Morgan, Pendleton, Randolph and Tucker

3. **APPLICABILITY:** The requirements as outlined in Loan Guaranty Information Letter 26-03-14 are equally applicable to the additional Virginia independent cities and counties and West Virginia counties listed above.
