




Most of the forms linked to this page are in Adobe Acrobat format and require Adobe Acrobat reader for viewing and printing. Perhaps the most common problem that people encounter printing involves the elimination of all spaces in the printed document. The document may look fine on the screen, but when it prints there are no spaces between words or sentences. For most people, choosing file and then print within Acrobat Reader brings up the following dialog box.



For most printers, these settings work fine. If you experience the problem noted above, check the “Print as image” so your screen looks like this.



Another problem you may encounter occurs when printing VA Form 26-1839 and any of the VA Form 26-6705's. In most cases, these forms will automatically print out in 8 ½ X 11 format. This may be a little too small for some people to use. The form is designed to support printers that use legal size (8 ½ X 14) paper. To print on legal size paper, open the appropriate document and click on "file", then "page setup". The following screen will appear:



Note the paper size is set at 8 ½ X 11 inches.

Use the scroll down arrow to select Legal (8 ½ X 14 inches), then print the document.
